



In **The Headmaster's Son**, a nostalgic and faintly disturbing juvenile romp through the 1980s, Richard Herring considers what could possibly be worse than being a podgy, swotty, virginal schoolboy.

What if your dad's the headmaster too? It's 1981 at the Kings of Wessex Upper School in Cheddar in Somerset, and this is the nightmare reality for our embryonic comic hero, son of Mr TK 'The Kipper' Herring. How on earth does he cope? And what

will be the psychological repercussions on his adult life?... 'TK Junior' dusts off his old diaries, rekindles memories that might have been best left forgotten and picks the scab off wounds that he thought had healed. Can he blame his adult failures on his youthful predicament? Was he, as he suspected, going to live a life of historical and philosophical import: a sort of better version of Gandhi and Jesus combined? Or would he just end up telling knob jokes for a living?
